



## Warrington Hospital Emergency Department Monthly Bulletin: April 2013 to March 2014

This bulletin provides a breakdown of all injury attendances at Warrington Hospital Emergency Department (ED) between April 2013 and March 2014.

Between April 2013 and March 2014 there were 41,176 ED attendances. This report is inclusive of data from Halton Minor Injuries Unit (n=12,375).

Injury attendances peaked in July (n=4,254), with February (n=2,681) having the least number of injury attendances (**Figure 1**).

There were slightly more male injury attendances than female presenting at Warrington Hospital ED (53%).

**Figure 2** presents the age group of injury attendances. Across the whole year, injury attendances were highest for individuals aged 30-59 years (33%).

**Table 1** details the injury group for attendances. The majority of attendances were classified as other injury (80%), 8% were recorded as being a sports injury and 6% as road traffic collision.

**Table 2** illustrates the source of referral for patients presenting with injuries. The majority (94%) of injury attendees self-referred.

**Table 3** presents injury attendances by location of incident. Over a third (36%) of attendances were recorded as occurring at home and 6% were reported as being located in a public place.

**Table 4** shows the discharge destination of injury attendances. Thirty-eight per cent of attendees were discharged without requiring any follow-up treatment and a quarter (25%) were discharged requiring follow-up treatment by a General Practitioner (GP). Eleven per cent were referred to a fracture clinic and one in ten (10%) were admitted to the hospital.

**Assault** attendees presenting at Warrington Hospital ED between April 2013 and March 2014 were mainly male (73%) and over half (51%) were aged between 15 and 29 years.

**Table 5** shows that 20% of assaults occurred in a home, 10% in a public place and 5% at work.

Figure 1: Gender of injury attendances by month, April 2013 to March 2014




Figure 2: Age group of injury attendances by month, April 2013 to March 2014


