

## Monthly Bulletin: July 2011 to June 2012

This bulletin provides a breakdown of all injury attendances at Chorley and South Ribble Hospital Emergency Department (ED) between July 2011 and June 2012.

Between July 2011 and June 2012 there were 25,573 attendances to Chorley and South Ribble Hospital ED. The month with the highest attendances was July with 2,474 attendances (**Figure 1**). There were more male than female attendances presenting at Chorley and South Ribble Hospital ED (males=13,888; 54%).

**Figure 2** illustrates the age group of ED attendances for each month. The majority of ED attendances were aged 30-59 (n=8,489; 33%) and 26% were 15-29 years old (n=6,525).

**Table 1** details the injury group of ED attendances. In half (50%) of all attendances, injury group was recorded as other injury. Falls accounted for 32% of attendances, sports injury 8%, road traffic collisions (RTC) 6% and assaults 3%.

**Table 2** shows the location of incident for patients attending Chorley and South Ribble Hospital ED. The primary incident location for injury attendances was in the home, where over a third (34%) of injuries occurred. This was followed by other location (17%) and public place (16%). The discharge destination for injury attendances is displayed in **Table 3**. It indicates that almost six in ten (57%) attendances

were discharged with no follow-up treatment. Nearly two in ten (17%) attendances were discharged into the care of their GP and 12% were referred to the fracture clinic.

#### Assault attendances


Between July 2011 and June 2012 there were 669 assault attendances to Chorley and South Ribble Hospital ED. The month with the highest attendance was March with 67 attendances (**Figure 3**). There were more male than female assault attendances presenting at Chorley and South Ribble General Hospital ED (males=452; 68%).


**Table 4** details the age group of assault attendancesfor each month. The majority of ED assaultattendances were aged 15-29 (n=338; 51%) and 40%were 30-59 years old (n=268).


**Table 5** illustrates the incident location for assault attendances to Chorley and South Ribble Hospital ED. The primary incident locations for assault attendances were in a public place (31%) and other location (29%), followed by in the home (13%).

The discharge destination for assault attendances is displayed in **Table 6**. It indicates that half (50%) of assault attendances were discharged with no follow-up treatment. Nearly four in ten required follow-up treatment (39%) and 3% of assault attendees were admitted into hospital.


