

## **Royal Lancaster Infirmary Emergency Department**

## Monthly Bulletin: April 2007 to March 2008

This bulletin provides a breakdown of all injury attendances at Royal Lancaster Infirmary Emergency Department (ED) between April 2007 and March 2008.

Between April 2007 and March 2008 there were 21,140 injury attendances to Royal Lancaster Infirmary ED. The month with the highest attendance was June with 2,060 attendances (**Figure 1**). There were more male than female attendances presenting at Lancaster Royal Infirmary ED (males=11,929; 56%).

**Figure 2** illustrates age group of ED attendances for each month. The majority of ED attendances were aged 15-29 (n=6,326; 30%) and 30-59 (n=6,393; 30%).

The referral source of injury attendances to the Royal Lancaster Infirmary ED are shown in **Table 1**. Most ED attendances self-referred (64%), 17% had their referral method recorded as emergency services and 16% were recorded as other.

**Table 2** details the injury group of ED attendances. For the majority (83%) of attendances, injury group was recorded as other injury. Sports injury accounted for 7% of attendances, 7% were road traffic collisions (RTC) and 2% were assaults.

**Table 3** shows the location of incident for injury attendances; nearly half (44%) of incident locations

were recorded as other location. This was followed by home (25%) and in a public place (18%).

**Table 4** illustrates the discharge destination for patients attending Royal Lancaster Infirmary ED. Under half (49%) of attendances were discharged, 19% were discharged to the care of their GP and 12% referred to the fracture clinic, while one in ten (11%) were admitted to hospital.

## **Assault attendances**

Between April 2007 and March 2008 there were 490 assault attendances to Royal Lancaster Infirmary ED. The month with the highest attendance was January with 50 attendances (**Figure 3**). There were more male than female assault attendances presenting at Lancaster Royal Infirmary ED (males=350; 71%).

**Table 5** shows age group of assault attendances for each month. The majority of ED assault attendances were aged 15-29 (n=278; 57%) and 32% were 30-59 years old (n=156).

**Table 6** illustrates the location of incident for assault attendances to Royal Lancaster Infirmary ED. The primary incident location for ED assault attendances was other (45%), followed by public place (35%).

**Table 7** shows the discharge destination for assault attendees. Under half (43%) of assault attendances were discharged. Over a third (35%) required follow-up treatment, while 9% were admitted to hospital.

Figure 1: ED injury attendances by gender and month, April 2007 to March 2008




Figure 2: Age group of ED injury attendances by month, April 2007 to March 2008



Figure 3: Number of ED assault attendances by gender and month, April 2007 to March 2008


