

Monthly Bulletin: January to December 2010

This bulletin provides a breakdown of all injury attendances at Royal Lancaster Infirmary Emergency Department (ED) between January and December 2010.

Between January and December 2010 there were 17,722 injury attendances to Royal Lancaster Infirmary ED. The month with the highest attendance was May with 1,713 attendances (**Figure 1**). There were more male than female attendances presenting at Lancaster Royal Infirmary ED (males=9,968; 56%).

Figure 2 illustrates age group of ED attendances for each month. The majority of ED attendances were aged 30-59 (n=5,226; 29%) and 15-29 (n=5,214; 29%).

The referral source of injury attendances to the Royal Lancaster Infirmary ED are shown in **Table 1.** Most ED attendances self-referred (58%), 21% had their referral method recorded as other and 16% were referred by the emergency services.

Table 2 details the injury group of ED attendances. For the majority (80%) of attendances, injury group was recorded as other injury. Sports injury accounted for 10% of attendances, 7% were road traffic collisions (RTC) and 2% were assaults.

Table 3 shows the location of incident for injury attendances, almost a third (32%) of incident locations were recorded as other. This was followed

by incidents in the home (30%) and in a public place (26%). **Table 4** illustrates the discharge destination for patients attending Royal Lancaster Infirmary ED. Almost six in ten (59%) of attendances were discharged, 15% were referred to the fracture clinic and 11% were admitted to hospital, while 7% were discharged in to the care of their GP.

Assault attendances






Figure 3: Number of ED assault attendances by gender and month, January to December 2010

Between January and December 2010 there were 421 assault attendances to Royal Lancaster Infirmary ED. The month with the highest attendance was June with 49 attendances (**Figure 3**). There were more male than female assault attendances presenting at Lancaster Royal Infirmary ED (males=318; 76%).

Table 5 shows age group of assault attendances for each month. The majority of ED assault attendances were aged 15-29 (n=240; 57%) and 35% were 30-59 years old (n=148).

Table 6 illustrates the location of incident for assault attendances to Royal Lancaster Infirmary ED. The primary incident location for assault attendances was other (50%), followed by public place (31%).

Table 7 shows the discharge destination for assaultattendees. More than half (54%) of assaultattendances were discharged. Over a fifth (22%)required follow-up treatment, while over one in ten(11%) were admitted to hospital.








