

## **Royal Preston Hospital Emergency Department**

## Monthly Bulletin: April 2007 to March 2008

This bulletin provides a breakdown of all injury attendances at Royal Preston Hospital Emergency Department (ED) between April 2007 and March 2008.

Between April 2007 and March 2008 there were 30,876 attendances to Royal Preston Hospital ED. The month with the highest attendance was April with 2,848 attendances (**Figure 1**). There were more male than female attendances presenting at Royal Preston Hospital ED (males=17,610; 57%).

**Figure 2** illustrates age group of ED attendances for each month. The majority of ED attendances were aged 15-29 (n=10,039; 33%) and 31% were 30-59 years old (n=9,425).

**Table 1** details the injury group of ED attendances. For over two-fifths (42%) of attendances, injury group was recorded as other injury. Falls accounted for 32% of attendances, road traffic collisions (RTC) 10%, sports injury 9% and assaults 6%.

**Table 2** illustrates the location of incident for patients attending the Royal Preston Hospital ED. The primary locations of injury were public place, where almost a third (32%) of injuries occurred. This was followed by the home (31%) and work (10%). The discharge destination for injury attendances is displayed in **Table 3**. It indicates that over half (58%) of attendances were discharged with no follow-up treatment. More than one in ten (12%) were

discharged into the care of their GP, 9% of attendances went to the fracture clinic and 9% were admitted to hospital.

## **Assault attendances**

Between April 2007 and March 2008 there were 1,890 assault attendances to Royal Preston Hospital ED. The month with the highest attendance was June with 183 attendances (**Figure 3**). There were more male than female assault attendances presenting at Royal Preston Hospital ED (males=1,406; 74%).

**Table 4** details the age group of assault attendances for each month. The majority of ED assault attendances were aged 15-29, (n=1,139; 60%) and a third (33%) were aged 30-59 (n=631).

**Table 5** illustrates the incident location for assault attendances to Royal Preston Hospital ED. The primary incident locations for assault attendances were in a public place (67%), followed by home (15%) and other (5%).

The discharge destination for assault attendances is displayed in **Table 6**. It indicates that less than half (47%) of assault attendances were discharged with no follow-up treatment. Almost a third (30%) of attendances required follow-up treatment and one in ten (10%) of assault attendees were admitted to hospital.

Figure 1: Gender of ED injury attendances by month, April 2007 to March 2008




Figure 2: Percentage of ED injury attendances by age group and month, April 2007 to March 2008



Figure 3: Number of ED assault attendances by gender and month, April 2007 to March 2008


