

Monthly Bulletin: January to December 2009

This bulletin provides a breakdown of all <u>injury</u> attendances at Royal Preston Hospital Emergency Department (ED) between January and December 2009.

Between January and December 2009 there were 30,950 attendances to Royal Preston Hospital ED. The month with the highest attendance was June with 2,827 attendances (**Figure 1**). There were more male than female attendances presenting at Royal Preston Hospital ED (males=17,514; 57%).




Figure 2: Percentage of ED injury attendances by Age group and month, January to December 2009

Figure 2 illustrates age group of ED attendances for each month. The majority of ED attendances were aged 15-29 (n=9,825; 32%) and 30% were 30-59 years old (n=9,192).

Table 1 details the injury group of ED attendances. For over a third (38%) of attendances, injury group was recorded as other accident. Of those injury groups recorded, falls accounted for 36% of attendances, road traffic collisions (RTC) 11%, sports injury 9% and assaults 6%.

Table 2 illustrates the location of incident for patients attending the Royal Preston Hospital ED. The primary locations of injury were public place, where almost third (30%) of injuries occurred. This was followed by the home (30%) and other location (10%). The discharge destination for injury attendances is displayed in **Table 3**. It indicates that over half (58%) of attendances were discharged with

no follow up treatment. One in ten attendances went to the fracture clinic (10%) or were admitted to hospital (10%).

Assault attendances

Between January and December 2009 there were 1,831 assault attendances to Royal Preston Hospital ED. The month with the highest attendance was March with 196 attendances (**Figure 3**). There were more male than female assault attendances presenting at Royal Preston Hospital ED (males=1,346; 74%).

Table 4 details the age group of assault attendances for each month. The majority of ED assault attendances were aged 15-29, (n=1,110; 61%) and a third (33%) were aged 30-59 (n=607).

Table 5 illustrates the incident location for assault attendances to Royal Preston Hospital ED. The primary incident locations for assault attendances were in a public place (61%), this was followed by home (14%) and other (12%).

The discharge destination for assault attendances is displayed in **Table 6**. It indicates that more than half (51%) of assault attendances were discharged with no follow up treatment. Over a fifth (23%) of attendances required follow-up treatment and 12% of assault attendees were admitted to hospital.

Figure 1: Gender of ED injury attendances by month, January to December 2009



Figure 3: Number of ED assault attendances by gender and month, January to December 2009


