

Monthly Bulletin: January to December 2010

This bulletin provides a breakdown of all injury attendances at Royal Preston Hospital Emergency Department (ED) between January and December 2010.

Between January and December 2010 there were 31,166 attendances to Royal Preston Hospital ED. The month with the highest attendance was April with 2,900 attendances (**Figure 1**). There were more male than female attendances presenting at Royal Preston Hospital ED (males=17,410; 56%).




Figure 2: Percentage of ED injury attendances by age group and month, January to December 2010

Figure 2 illustrates age group of ED attendances for each month. The majority of ED attendances were aged 30-59 (n=9,361; 30%) and 30% were 15-29 years old (n=9,205).

Table 1 details the injury group of ED attendances.In two-fifths (40%) of attendances, injury group wasrecorded as falls. Other injury accounted for 36% ofattendances, road traffic collisions (RTC) 10%, sportsinjury 9% and assaults 5%.

Table 2 illustrates the location of incident for patients attending the Royal Preston Hospital ED. The primary locations of injury were home (30%) and public place (30%). This was followed by other location (9%). The discharge destination for injury attendances is displayed in **Table 3**. It indicates that over half (53%) of attendances were discharged with no follow-up treatment. Just over one in ten (13%)

attendances were discharged into the care of their GP and 12% went to the fracture clinic.

Assault attendances

Between January and December 2010 there were 1,632 assault attendances to Royal Preston Hospital ED. The month with the highest attendance was April with 168 attendances (**Figure 3**). There were more male than female assault attendances presenting at Royal Preston Hospital ED (males=1,194; 73%).

Table 4 details the age group of assault attendances for each month. The majority of ED assault attendances were aged 15-29, (n=974; 60%) and over a third (34%) were aged 30-59 (n=551).

Table 5 illustrates the incident location for assault attendances to Royal Preston Hospital ED. The primary incident locations for assault attendances were in a public place (64%), followed by home (14%) and other (9%).

The discharge destination for assault attendances is displayed in **Table 6**. It indicates that less than half (45%) of assault attendances were discharged with no follow-up treatment. Almost three in ten (29%) of assault attendances required follow-up treatment and 13% were admitted to hospital.






