

## Monthly Bulletin: October 2012 to September 2013

This bulletin provides a breakdown of all injury attendances to the Royal Blackburn Hospital Emergency Department (ED) and Urgent Care Centre (UCC), and Burnley General Hospital UCC between October 2012 and September 2013.

In this twelve month period, there were 64,403 ED and UCC attendances. The month with the highest number of attendances was July 2013 with 6,041 compared to 4,644 in February 2013 (**Figure 1**).

There were more male than female attendees presenting at the ED and UCCs (males=34,604; 54%) (**Figure 1**).

**Figure 2** illustrates the age group of ED and UCC attendances for each month. Over a third (34%) of the attendees were aged 30-59 years (n=22,178), followed by almost three in ten (29%) aged 15-29 years (n=18,504).

The source of referral for attendances between October 2012 and September 2013 is detailed in **Table 1**. Over a quarter (n=17,587; 27%) of attendees were brought in by a parent, with the same proportion brought in by others (n=17,400; 27%). Twenty-six per cent of attendees were self-referred to the ED and UCCs (n=16,955) and 16% were referred by the ambulance service (n=10,003).

**Table 2** shows the injury group of ED and UCC attendances. The majority (n=56,167; 87%) were recorded as other injury. Sports injury accounted for 5% of attendances (n=2,989), road traffic collisions 4% (n=2,855) and assaults 3% (n=2,102).

The discharge destination for injury attendances to the ED and UCCs is displayed in **Table 3**. Over twofifths (44%) were discharged with no follow-up treatment required (n=28,458) and 13% were discharged to their General Practitioner (GP) (n=8,096). Nine per cent of attendees were referred to the fracture/ orthopaedic clinic (n=6,060) and 8% discharged to a GP within Burnley General Hospital (n=5,175).

## **Assault attendances**


Between October 2012 and September 2013 there were 2,102 assault attendances to the ED and UCCs. The month with the highest number was December 2012 with 222 attendances (**Figure 3**). Over seven in ten (73%) of assault attendees were male (males=1,531) (**Figure 3**).

**Table 4** details the age group of assault attendances for each month. Over half (53%) of assault attendees were aged 15-29 years (n=1,122), followed by 38% aged 30-59 years (n=795).

The source of referral for assault attendances to the ED and UCCs are displayed in **Table 5**. The primary source of referral for assault attendances was by ambulance (n=713; 34%). Over two-fifths (21%) were self-referred (n=434), 17% brought in by others (n=366) and 17% brought in by a parent (n=361).


**Table 6** demonstrates the discharge destination of assault attendances in October 2012 to September 2013. Almost half (48%) of all assault attendees were discharged with no follow-up required (n=1,015). Three in ten (30%) required follow-up treatment (n=627) and 11% were admitted to hospital (n=239).


