

Alder Hey Children's Hospital Emergency Department Monthly Bulletin: April 2010 to March 2011

This bulletin provides a breakdown of attendances presenting with injuries to Alder Hey Children's Hospital Emergency Department (ED), between April 2010 and March 2011.

Between April 2010 and March 2011 there were 20,399 ED injury attendances. The peak month for injury attendance was June (n=2,183), with December (n=889) accounting for the fewest. For each month there were more male (58%) injury attendances than female presenting at Alder Hey ED and patients aged 10 to 14 years (37%) were the largest group of injury attendances (**Figures 1** and **2**).

The majority (92%) of injury attendances between April 2010 and March 2011 were recorded as other injury. This can cover incidents such as a body injury

or laceration (Table 1).

Table 2 illustrates the location where other injuries occurred. The primary locations were in the home (41%), in a public place (19%) and in an education establishment (19%).

Table 3 illustrates the method of discharge of injury attendances. Almost two thirds (65%) of all injury attendances were discharged.

Assault attendees presenting at Alder Hey Children's Hospital ED between April 2010 and March 2011 were mainly male (65%) and aged between 10 and 14 years (64%). The primary location of assaults was recorded as a public place (52%).

Figure 1: Gender of injury attendances by month, April 2010 to March 2011




Figure 2: Age group of injury attendances by month, April 2010 to March 2011


